From July, but gradually, passports at all post offices!

The experimentation began last March 14th in some offices in the Bologna area. But from July it will be possible to request a PASSPORT in all Italian Post Offices (around 13,000). The extension of the service **will take place gradually**, therefore it will no longer concern only the municipalities falling under the Polis project (under 15,000 inhabitants). This innovation will reduce delays and waiting times to obtain the document, thus supporting the work of the Police Headquarters.

How to request it?

Without going to the Police Headquarters, the citizen will be able to open the process of requesting or renewing a passport by presenting the appropriate documentation directly at the Post Office. It will also be possible to receive the passport directly at home. You will need to bring with you a valid identity document, tax code, two photographs, pay the postal payment for an ordinary passport worth 42.50 euros and pay 73.50 euros for a revenue stamp. The operator, himself, will collect the biometric data (fingerprints and photos), then he will send the documentation to the relevant Police Office which will manage the practice assigning the citizen a protocol number.
