## Fines for traffic violations of the Code must respect notification times, under penalty of nullity

In general, the time-barring of fines is five years from the last notification, unless notices or payment reminders have been received during this period. In this case a new count of 5 years starts from that date.

The time-barring of fines after 90 days has a different regulation (violations that are not notified immediately, such as speeding violations by speed cameras or Tutors), if the first notification arrives after this deadline, it is possible to request its cancellation through the Justice of the Peace.

In any case, it is always necessary to appeal, in order not to pay fines that arrived or were requested late, after 90 days or 5 years, depending on the case

N.B. according to paragraph 3 of art. 149 of the Code of Civil Procedure, the notification is completed, for the notifying party, after the report will be delivered to the Messi Service.
