

The catalog scam!

Under the guise of a simple signature on a receipt for receiving a catalog or a discount card, a contract is activated in which the unfortunate victim undertakes to pay even very high amounts.

What to watch out for!

Beware of sellers who claim to deliver only a catalog, usually of household items, in which special discounts are included and ask for a “simple signature”. The goal of scammers, once the signature on the contract is obtained, becomes to let the 14 days pass during which the consumer could exercise his right to withdraw from the purchase. After that period the scammer shows up at home inducing the user to respect the terms of the signed contract and, without adequate explanations, obliges him to make purchases even for three/four years, with a minimum spending obligation. It is important not to accept delivery of the goods under any circumstances, and to send a registered letter or certified email to exercise the right of withdrawal, which is valid starting from the awareness of the signature on the contract.
